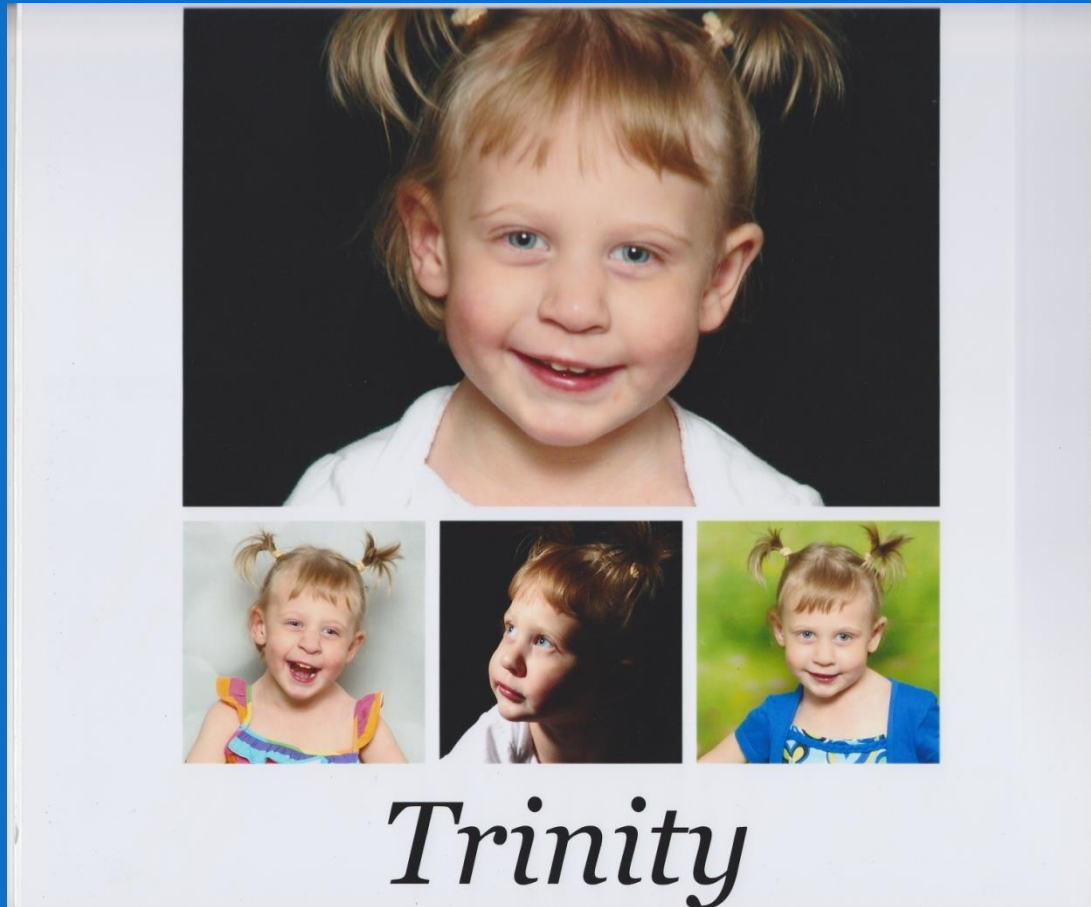

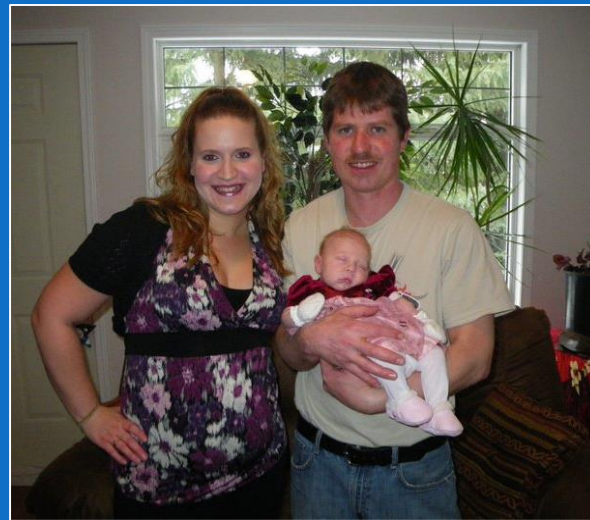

- Systemic

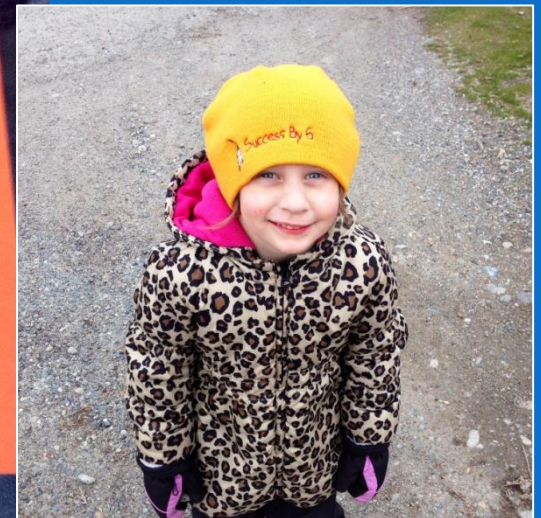


Trinity's development has been a journey right from the start and we have always been committed to her early intervention

The Convention on The Rights of The Child

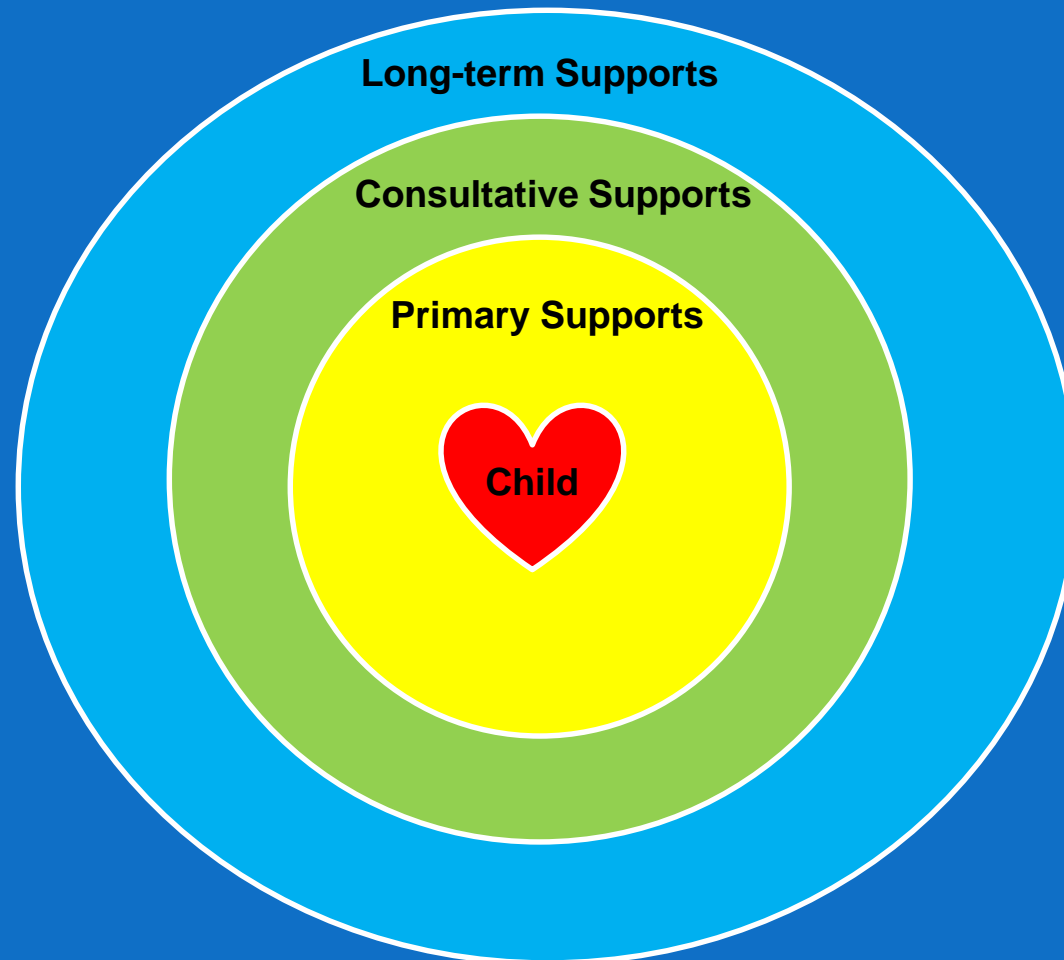
Article 23

You have the right to special education and care if you have a disability, as well as all the rights in this Convention, so that you can live a full life

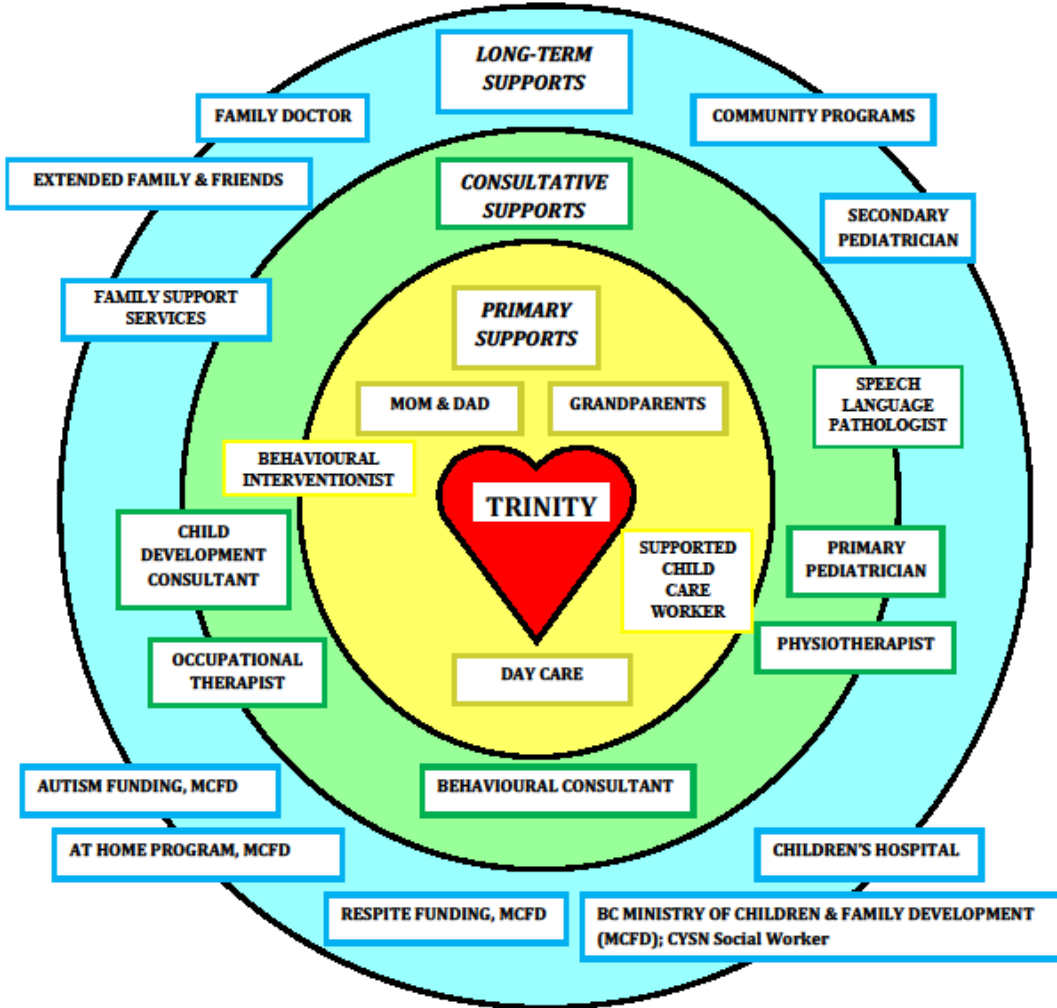


“All children have a right to individually appropriate care that meets their needs, develops their gifts, and helps them reach their potential.”
